

#### Methodology



Refine the questions.



Broadcast the survey.



Goal of 500+ survey responses.




Ask respondents if they'd participate in a longer survey.



Attempt to balance the results to the population.



Decide what to do next.





#### **RESULTS**



86% think having diverse housing options is important, very important or extremely important.



73% do NOT think having a variety of housing negatively impacts their community's culture.



72% have struggled with or know someone who has struggled to afford housing in the county.



# 88% do NOT think there is enough affordable housing for older adults.



89% do NOT think there is enough affordable housing for young adults and recent graduates.

#### Define "Affordable"



## "Affordable" Apartment Rent \$1,103 Actual Apartment Rent \$1,552

(one-bedroom)

#### **CONTEXT**

\$50,000/salary \$40,000/take home = 47% for housing



### "Affordable" Home Mortgage \$1,529 Actual Home Mortgage \$2,495

#### **CONTEXT**

\$100,000/salary \$80,000/take home = 37% for housing



**Concern: DENSITY** 

50% / 50% worry about rising density.

#### **Concern: HOME VALUES**

43%

worry about impact on home values

**57%** 

do NOT worry about the impact

#### What's next?
