HAND (Hamilton County Area Neighborhood Development) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to addressing the housing needs of low- and moderate-income individuals and families in the northern suburbs of Indianapolis, including Hamilton, Boone, and Tipton counties. Established in 2003, we envision a community where everyone can thrive with a full range of quality housing options for every stage of life.

HAND is the only state-designated Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO) in Hamilton County. Its 12-member board of directors provides oversight for a staff of three.

WHAT WE DO

HAND develops, owns, and manages 11 affordable rental properties designed to create sustainable and vibrant communities. Our properties meet LEED standards, incorporate energy-efficient appliances, and follow Universal Design principles to ensure accessibility. We advocate for diverse housing solutions to strengthen the local economy and promote inclusivity.
