HAND is guided by a board of directors currently made up of 12 dedicated community members, and we are expanding to 15 members in 2026. By design, one-third of our board seats are held by low-income residents or their representatives, ensuring that those most impacted by housing decisions have a voice at the table. Board members serve three-year terms and commit to regular meetings, committee service, and community engagement.

As we grow, HAND is especially seeking new members with expertise in affordable housing development, marketing and public relations, and law. Many of our board members first got involved through committee service, which is a great way to learn about HAND and explore long-term leadership.
